COVID-19 Summary for Parents

- ❖ School hours are 9.20am to 3.00pm for all pupils. (Please note the staggered times for each family during Covid-19).
- ❖ Drop off/Pick up at the entrance maintaining 2m distance. Please do not delay under any circumstances.
- ❖ To pick up a child during school hours, please phone first.
- ❖ There will be no access to the classroom for parents or visitors, bar exceptional circumstances.
- ❖ All staff will complete COVID induction training.
- ❖ We will prioritise outdoor learning where possible. Pupils should bring a warm waterproof jacket, to keep dry during opening time, breaks and closing time of school.
- ❖ As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a mask/visor.
- ❖ Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using proper technique.
- ❖ Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit.
- ❖ The class will be cleaned daily. Toys will be disinfected weekly.
- ❖ Only lunches will be brought to school from 31st August for the foreseeable future.
- ❖ There will be no homework assigned for the month of September. This will be reviewed.
- ❖ Pupils must be kept home with cold/flu, high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell. Pupils must be kept home if generally unwell.
- ❖ Pupils must stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.
- ❖ If showing symptoms, pupils will be isolated and parents called. Parents will contact GP.
- ❖ Our school is divided into each class bubble. Parents will be informed of any confirmed case within that “bubble”.
- ❖ Physical distancing is not required from Junior Infants - 2nd Class. Pods will be spaced 1m apart; however pupils will mix during the day.
- ❖ All pupils will have their own stationery and supplies which will be kept in school.
- ❖ Shared resources will be minimised but will be wiped down at the end of the day if used.
- ❖ It is essential that you provide up-to-date contact details, emergency contact details and an email address, if possible.
